Community Garden Volunteers will:

- Organize and catalogue seeds.
- Build small structures in the garden like fencing, garden boxes, compost bins and trellises.
- Assist with garden chores like tilling soil, planting, weeding and watering.
- Help with implementation of community garden events such as trainings on container gardening, introduction to bees, harvesting and preserving, managing garden pests and putting the garden to bed
- Organize tool and garden shed
- Help clean blighted lots and transform them into more attractive spaces.
